RESULTS OF ORTHOPEDIC RADIOGRAPHY

Thank you for bringing your dog to us for radiographic orthopedic examination. The results of our examination(s) are given below:

Preliminary Hip Exam (dog less than 18 months old):

- The conformation of your dog's hip joints is within normal limits for age and breed. Because hip dysplasia is a developmental disease which may not be apparent in a young dog, re-examination at 18 months of age or older is recommended (required for WCVM certification).
- The radiographs of your dog's hip joints show signs of mild/moderate/severe hip dysplasia.

Definitive Hip Exam (dog more than 18 months old):

- Normal hip joints with fair/good/excellent hip conformation compared with other dogs of the same breed. A WCVM Hip Dysplasia Certificate will be issued.
- The radiographs of your dog's hip joints show signs of mild/moderate/severe hip dysplasia.

- Elbow Exam:** Normal elbow joint(s).
- Signs of elbow dysplasia. (FCP/OCD/UAP)
